TAK Elul *Fast of T'Shuvah* Daily Prayer Points Sundown, September 3—Sundown, October 1, 2024

Day 1: Tuesday, September 3 (Pray @ 7:30 PM this day only) There has never been a more desperate time for Adonai's people to rise up in unity and fall down in repentance. Only then will we be able to stand firm on Adonai's promise to redeem, restore, and revive this broken nation. While we desire for Adonai to change this nation, we must first be willing to change ourselves. There is Hope for our great nation, it lies within each one of us. Help us Adonai to make T'Shuvah. (2 Chronicles 7:14).

Day 2: Wednesday, September 4: Pray to hear Adonai's voice more clearly as we seek His face: My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me (John 10:27).

Day 3: Thursday, September 5: Pray for Adonai's plans for Israel to be established (Psalm 33: 10-11), and for Adonai to thwart the plans of Israel's enemies. Pray that America will continue to stand with Israel and stay under Adonai's covenant blessing. (Genesis 12:3).

Day 4: Friday, September 6 (FASTING FOR AMERICA DAY): For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, so that Messiah may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Messiah which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God. (Ephesians 3:14-19).

Day 5: Saturday, September 7: Pray for an increase of the true love of God to manifest within our daily lives: May the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the steadfastness of Messiah (2 Thessalonians 3:5) Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered, does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails (1 Corinthians 13:4-8a).

Day 6: Sunday, September 8: Pray to guard your speech: Who is the man who desires life and loves length of days that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking deceit. Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it... I will guard my ways that I may not sin with my tongue (Psalm 34:12-14; 39:1) Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear (Ephesians 4:29).

Day 7: Monday, September 9: Pray for the Kingdom Youth of TAK and the Shabbat School Ministry: and (Yeshua) said, "Truly I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven... Let the children alone, and do not hinder them from coming to Me; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." (Matthew 18:3; 19:14)

Day 8: Tuesday, September 10: Pray for the various TAK ministries: keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. Be hospitable to one another... as good stewards of the manifold grace of God (1 Peter 4:8-10).

Day 9: Wednesday, September 11: Pray for the men of TAK: Be on the alert, stand firm in the faith, bond together like men of valor and be strong. Let all that you do be done in love (1 Corinthians 16:13-14).

Day 10: Thursday, September 12: Pray for divine protection and favor over our children starting school this year:

The Lord will protect you from all evil; He will keep your soul. The Lord will guard your going out and your coming in from this time forth and forever (Psalm 121:7-8).

Day 11: Friday, September 13 (FASTING FOR AMERICA DAY): Is this not the fast which I choose, to loosen the bonds of wickedness, to undo the bands of the yoke, and to let the oppressed go free and break every yoke? Then your light will break out like the dawn, and your recovery will speedily spring forth; and your righteousness will go before you; the glory of the LORD will be your rear guard (Isaiah 58:6, 8; Daniel 10:2-3).

Day 12: Saturday, September 14: Pray as we humble ourselves before you, O lord, that you teach us to forgive and forget the wrongs suffered us and not so easily "take offense." Help us lay down our pride for your Kingdom's sake. (Psalm 130:3-4, Micah 7:18).

Day 13: Sunday, September 15: Pray for the Lord's plans for Israel to be established and for God to thwart the plans of Israel's enemies: The LORD nullifies the counsel of the nations; He frustrates the plans of the peoples. The counsel of the LORD stands forever, the plans of His heart from generation to generation (Psalm 33:10-11).

Day 14: Monday, September 16: Pray for reconciliation and restoration of marriages and other relationships: God was in Messiah reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:19)

Day 15: Tuesday, September 17: Pray for revival of our first love with Yeshua: We love, because He first loved us. (1 John 4:19).

Day 16: Wednesday, September 18: Pray for the body of Messiah to receive their divine inheritance and walk in divine health and healing from all manner of sickness, disease, and infirmity: Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits; Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases; Who redeems your life from the pit, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion; Who satisfies your years with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle (Psalm 103:1-5). But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed (Isaiah 53:5).

- **Day 17: Thursday, September 19:** Pray for any spirits of unforgiveness, bitterness, and resentment to be revealed and uprooted from our hearts: See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble, and by it many become defiled (Hebrews 12:15).
- Day 18: Friday, September 20 (FASTING FOR AMERICA DAY): Pray for the spirits of conviction and humility to release national repentance in the United States: Lord, I have heard the report about You and I fear. O Lord, revive Your work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make it known; in wrath remember mercy. (Habakkuk 3:2).
- **Day 19: Saturday, September 21:** Pray for Ruach HaKodesh to draw the Jewish community through our efforts to reach out to them, unto Adonai, and that we can be a light in the dark areas of our surrounding community also. No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day (John 6:44).
- Day 20: Sunday, September 22: Pray for the salvation of the lost sheep of the house of Israel: (And the LORD said) "Prophesy over these bones and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.' Thus says the Lord God to these bones, 'Behold, I will cause breath to enter you that you may come to life. I will put sinews on you, make flesh grow back on you, cover you with skin and put breath in you that you may come alive; and you will know that I am the LORD'" (Ezekiel 37:4-6). Brethren, my heart's desire and my prayer to God for them is for their salvation (Romans 10:1).
- **Day 21: Monday, September 23:** Pray for the unity of the body of Messiah in these latter days: ...conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Messiah, so that...you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; in no way alarmed by your opponents—which is a sign of destruction for them, but of salvation for you, and that too, from God (Phil. 1:27-28).
- Day 22: Tuesday, September 24: Pray for our youth to have divinely inspired personal encounters with Ruach HaKodesh: I will pour out My Spirit on all mankind; and your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. "Even on the male and female servants I will pour out My Spirit in those days (Joel 2:28-29) but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth (Acts 1:8).
- **Day 23: Wednesday, September 25:** Pray no access for the spirit of fear: There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear (1 John 4:18). Pray also for Adonai's protection over our police and armed forces, that they will be able to use discernment and wisdom to protect us.
- Day 24: Thursday, September 26: Pray for open hearts and open doors to minister the love of God with pre-believers: "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (Deuteronomy 30:14) How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO BRING GOOD NEWS OF GOOD THINGS!"——(Romans 10:14-15).

Day 25: Friday, September 27 (FASTING FOR AMERICA DAY): Pray for an increase of faith (belief, trust, and reliance) in the LORD: Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear Him, on those who hope for His lovingkindness, to deliver their soul from death and to keep them alive in famine. Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and our shield. For our heart rejoices in Him, because we trust in His holy name. let Your lovingkindness, O Lord, be upon us, according as we have hoped in You (Psalm 33:18-22).

Day 26: Saturday, September 28: Pray for whoever is elected our next President and all those who will be elected to leadership positions in our local, state, and national elections, that they will stand up for our time-honored values in America for the Sanctity of Life, Traditional Marriage, family values, religious liberty, and support of Israel.

Day 27: Sunday, September 29: Pray that any plots of the enemy will be exposed and for divine protection over the people of God: For nothing is hidden, except to be revealed; nor has anything been secret, but that it would come to light (Mark 4:22).

Day 28: Monday, September 30: Pray for the TAK leadership as they prepare themselves to minister throughout the High Holy Days services: ...we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who examines our hearts. (Thessalonians 2:4).

Day 29: Tuesday, October 1: Pray for the TAK Praise and Worship ministry (musicians, singers, dancers, soundbooth) as they prepare for High Holy Day services: true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers (John 4:23) the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing (Isaiah 10:27).
